Public Safety Committee

Brad provided an update on the email campaign to community leaders concerning violent incidents at Zeeba Lounge. Zee Lounge and Arabian Nights are currently shut down and the issue is in court.

o Grant Updates – LPRs, Park Lights and Placemaking

Brad provided an update on the \$33,000 grant to improve lighting on Warren Avenue next to Federal Hill Park. DOT is reporting they don't have the resources to install the lights. Brad will continue to work with DOT to move the request forward.

Brad provided an update on the license plate reader (LPR) grant. FHNA is funding a LPR at Hanover and Hamburg. Zach reported the Federal Hill Main Street is potentially adding a LPR at Light and Key Highway

o Parking Audit Project

Bad provided an update on the Parking Audit Project. 748 parking spots in the neighborhood with 1,408 permits currently issued. In an audit conducted 4/2-17, 20% of cars were parked illegally. Brad will present data to the DOT at a meeting on 4/24.

Locchanan presented efforts to improve safety at Henrietta at Charles intersection. The proposed solution is to add a four-way stop, cross walks, pedestrian bump outs, bollards and street art to the intersection. 80 signatures of support have been collected from nearby neighbors.

Ondoria requested a list of all intersections identified by FHNA needing improvement so she can take them to DOT. Brad will conduct a survey and provide a list. Beth reported that there is an erroneous crosswalk at Light and Montgomery that needs to be removed.
