This Officer then searched the location and found that the suspects had cut off 22 locks from 22 storage lockers and opened same. Synopsis	<p>On 7 August 2022 at approximately 2312hrs, your writer, P/O C Allen (9A42/J193) of the Baltimore City Police Department, Southern District Patrol, responded to 1626 Light Street Baltimore MD 21230 for a report of an Unarmed Robbery. Upon arrival, your writer spoke with victim who advised that he had been assault by approximately ten male juveniles and robbed of his possessions. Further investigation revealed the following. Victim stated that on 7 August 2022 at approximately 2250hrs, he was walking alone on the 200 block of East Heath Street, Baltimore MD 21230. Victim stated that he heard footsteps running up from behind him. Victim stated that suddenly he was struck from behind in the back of the head in an unknown manner and fell to the ground. Victim stated that approximately ten male juveniles began punching and kicking him while he was on the ground. Victim stated that the juveniles then went through his pockets, stealing items. Medic 5 responded to the scene and treated victim for his injuries. Area canvass for additional suspects or witnesses proved negative at this time. Area canvass for private camera footage to be followed up. City watch cameras are not in the location. Southern District DDU arrived on scene.</p>	<p>Southern District, CAD: 4510, BWC Memorialized, Date: 08/08/2022, Time: Approximately 2331 Hours</p> <p>On Monday, August 8th, 2022 at approximately 2331 hours I arrived at S Charles St. and W. Cross St. in reference to a call for an aggravated assault by shooting with a bb gun (later determined to be a gel blaster). Upon my arrival, I met by both (victims).</p> <p>Victims advised that they the apartment (Unit W Cross St.) and were traveling on foot eastbound on the unit block of W. Cross St. Victim advised that a group of about 5-6 individuals (possibly juveniles) were traveling westbound on W Cross St. in the middle of the road. Victim reported that one of the individuals was a black male, possibly a juvenile, (approximately 5'-07", approximately 215lbs, stocky build) wearing a gray t-shirt, black shorts, and possibly black shoes. Suspect began shooting at both victims. First victim reported that he was struck twice on the left side of his head, once on the left side of his torso, and possibly one time on his backpack. Second victim advised that she was struck twice on her left cheek just below her eye and advised that she had two welts. Victim declined medical attention. A citizen contact card was issued. Southern District DDU was notified, and Detective Moore (3985, K429) responded to the scene. A Citywide broadcast was aired at 2358 hours.</p>
