Crime Update - Captain Brust

- Uptick in carjackings and armed robberies. Additional officers deployed to Federal Hill during high-volume times.
- Arrests have been made in the pattern of abductions and those incidents have since stopped.
- Increase in street robberies. One suspect has been identified.
- Question about the interaction between police and juvenile services. Captain Brust explained the process and the challenges that are faced.

Brad O'Brien provided the public safety updates.

- Brad reiterated the importance of cameras and requests that anyone with a camera register with the neighborhood.
- Previously awarded grants have led to increased lighting in the neighborhood and
