Brad presented an update on the license plate reader grant. BPD has completed two site surveys for the grants (Key & Lawrence / Hanover & Hamburg). The quote for the camera is \$51,000. The grant money must be sent by July 2023. Brad proposes FHNA allocates the grant money to BPD for three cameras at the Hanover & Hamburg intersection. (He is waiting for feedback on a potential 4th camera needed at the intersection. FHSNA is handling the Key & Lawrence cameras.)
